The Cardiff MHM team have been working with patients at St Davids this month. Exciting new interactive tech arrived and they were able to enjoy sensory activities with patients from Glan Ely Ward. The team have also been preparing for Easter with a wall display and egg colouring, music and dancing with the wonderful Rubicon Dance and music from Harmoni Cymru, all supported by funding from the Arts for Health & Wellbeing Programme. As part on an ongoing collaboration with Rubicon Dance, sessions have also been taking place for patients and staff to enjoy being connected and active.

Over the last year, the Forget-me-not Chorus, in partnership with Cardiff & Vale Health Charity have been running zoom sessions in St Davids Hospital, using song to connect with patients and collect music and stories. Across Cardiff and Vale University Health Board, Refill Stations have been installed for use by patients, staff and visitors to increase access to free drinking water and to cut down on plastic waste, Cardiff & Vale Health Charity have been pioneering the installation to promote healthy hydration
