The refurbishment of the previous phlebotomy room has now been completed. The pelvic health treatment room will be used by all members of the team, and we are aiming to begin treating patients in February 2022.

Initial patient feedback of the Pelvic Health Service has been very positive. Patients report feeling fully supported with the management of their health by having access to all members of the multidisciplinary team during their hospital appointments.
