
#### A New Wall Vinyl to be Installed at Cardiff Royal Infirmary

#### **CAVHIS Launched**

On Tuesday 28th September 2021 Cardiff Health Access Practice rebranded to The Cardiff and Vale Health Inclusion Service. A launch event took place to mark the positive changes ahead for vulnerable individuals within Cardiff and Vale. The revised service model will provide access to public health screening and short-term support for vulnerable individuals who find it hard to access healthcare and who are not registered with a GP. CAVHIS aims to provide this service with compassion, treating each individual with respect and dignity. CAVHIS was proud to welcome Councillor Susan Elsmore, Councillor Linda Thorne and Professor Charles Janczewski to cut the ribbon and say a few words to mark the occasion.


