fantastic to work with Jo- one of the Occupational Therapists at St David's with some music, dancing



Milestone Landmark for The Welsh Gender Service

The Welsh Gender Service has recently reached a milestone landmark in its delivery of care across Wales with the introduction of its first satellite clinic for patients in North Wales.

Based at St David's Hospital in Cardiff, the Welsh Gender Service is a tertiary service that provides holistic, patient-centred care focused on hormonal, psychological and social aspects of transition.

Delivering services for patients across Wales, to date patients have either accessed clinic appointments virtually, or have travelled to the capital for face-to-face appointments.

With a commitment to provide patients with a more equitable provision of face-to-face appointments, the Service has been working with

colleagues to develop satellite clinics across the nation to ensure these are more accessible for more individuals.

The clinics, which are staffed by Welsh Gender Service clinicians, will take place monthly, with patients being offered appointments based upon where they fall in the waiting list but with a choice of location; be that virtual, Cardiff or now North Wales.
